

RBT Competency Assessment

How to create your account, choose your track, and purchase the assessment bundle.

STEP 1 — CREATE YOUR ACCOUNT

Sign up so you can save progress, access your resource pack, and receive your competency materials.

- 1 Visit spicybehavioralinstitute.com/signup
- 2 Enter your name, email, and a password
- 3 Check your inbox and click the verification link
- 4 Return to the site and you'll be taken to your dashboard

STEP 2 — CHOOSE YOUR PATH

STEP 3 — OPEN THE RBT COMPETENCY ACADEMY
